


Instructions for Attaching BonusYards®

BonusYards® helps golfers produce longer, straighter, and more consistent drives by setting their shaft at the ideal 45 degree angle, which is the same shaft angle used by Ben Hogan, John Daly and Tiger Woods. (Amateurs typically set their shaft angles at 50 degrees, causing them to lose 25 yards or more in distance off the tee.)

1. Attach BonusYards® by slipping it onto the small end of the golf club shaft, and sliding it up the shaft and onto the grip. Because BonusYards® is designed to fit snugly on the grip, you may need to flex open the slot to get it onto the grip. Do this by holding the unit stationary by placing your left thumb on one of the flex legs, then rotating the grip clockwise with your right hand to "screw" the unit up the grip. When finished, BonusYards® should rest about one to two inches above the bottom edge of the grip. BonusYards® fits all standard grips, but not oversized grips.
2. Align BonusYards® by rotating it about the grip until its flat face (the surface on which BonusYards® is printed) points either directly toward or away from the target. The diagram below shows BonusYards® properly mounted on the grip.
3. Detach BonusYards® by rotating it around the grip to "screw" it downward until it comes off.

Instructions for Using BonusYards®

1. Address the ball as you normally do, with the club head resting on the ground. Raise or lower the grip until the bubble in BonusYards® is centered on the red line. When the bubble is centered on the red line, the shaft is at the ideal 45 degree angle for your driver.
2. Note the location of your hands at address because you must return your hands to this same position when striking the ball.
3. Execute your normal swing, keeping your club on plane during the backswing, and returning your hands to the address position when striking the ball.
4. When detached from the golf club, BonusYards® may be used to read greens. Stand it upright on the green and the bubble will move away from center, in the direction of the upslope.

BonusYards® is molded from tough, ballistic-grade polycarbonate plastic and is rugged enough to withstand high impacts and abuse.
